

Happening this month at My First School ...

Our school wide theme this month is "Jesus Loves Me"!

The 2's&3's class will be learning about rainbows, the five senses, and the Easter Story. They will be introduced to the oval shape, the colors yellow and green, and the number 10. They will be using their fine motor muscles to practice cutting with scissors.

Our 3's&4's classes will talk about the Easter Story, seasons, and St. Patrick's Day. They will learn to print first names, recognize their last names in print, and sequence pictures to tell a story. They will be working with the number 10, sorting and counting sets of objects, and using positional words (above, below, beside, etc.). They will focus on letters Uu, Vv, and Ww.

The Pre-K classes will be learning about St. Patrick's Day, rocks, and community helpers. They will practice patterning, line tracing, and connecting the dots. They will be working on adding and subtracting groups of items and use digital tools to express ideas. They will be focusing on the letters Dd, Nn, Rr, and Yy.
