MFS Monthly Theme: We Are Thankful

Our 2's & 3's class is learning to sort by color, the colors brown and green, and the numbers 5 and 6. They will talk about the autumn season, God's Harvest, Thanksgiving, and healthy foods. The shape of the month is the triangle.

The 3's & 4's classes will be focusing on the letters Hh, Ii, Jj, Kk, and numbers 0-5. They will be practicing tracing lines and names, counting objects in a group, and sorting by shape. They will talk about healthy foods, families and Thanksgiving traditions.

The Pre-K classes will be identifying and printing letters Ff, Ee, and Xx. They will work on patterning, graphing, and sounds that are the same and different. Pre-K will research turkeys and will discuss the difference between wants and needs.

Sleep and Preschoolers

Many parents wonder "How much sleep does my preschooler need?" Sleep is essential to our physical and mental health. The National Sleep Foundation's recommends 10-13 hours for preschoolers for nightly sleep. It's best for children to have a bedtime routine which includes:

- winding down for 30 minutes, ex: by reading or listening to relaxing music
- lowering the lights
- disconnecting from all devices such tablets, cell phones or laptops
