September

Monthly Theme: God Made Everything

Learning Concepts: Getting acquainted, #'s 0-5, Recognizing own first name



October

Monthly Theme: Fall and Family

Learning Concepts: Fire safety, Fall, shapes, #0-10, segmenting words by sound (syllabication)



November

Monthly Theme: We are Thankful

Learning Concepts: Fall harvest, Thanksgiving, rhyming, 1 to 1 correspondance



December

Monthly Theme: Jesus is Born

Learning Concepts: Birth of Christ, Christmas, recognizing and creating simple patterns, begin writing first name



January

Monthly Theme: Wonderful Winter

Learning Concepts: Winter, opposites, positional words, our five senses



February

Monthly Theme: Hugs and Kisses

Learning Concepts: Things that move, sequencing pictures to tell or retell a story, sorting and classifying sets, Valentine's Day



March

Monthly Theme: Signs of Spring

Learning Concepts: Needs and Wants, Dental Health, differentiate between same or different initial consonant sounds. recognize and name coins



Monthly Theme: Jesus Loves Me

Learning Concepts: Seasons, Easter, measure length and volume with nonstandard units. recognize and name words with same initial consonant



May

Monthly Theme: Our Outside World

Learning Concepts: Animals and babies, Moms and Dads, review all alphabet letters and sounds and #'s 0-10

Alphabet letters will be covered throughout the year as well. The class newsletter will have more specific information about what learning skills will be covered in the classroom. Remember that preschoolers learn best through play and repetition and so learning concepts need to be addressed many times throughout the school year. We want to give the children multiple exposures to concepts but don't expect full mastery of all the concepts at this age.
